



Dislocated Worker Program

Not all of our services require income eligibility. All adults are welcome to come into our centers and receive core services. If you are interested in additional training services, you must qualify under certain criteria. Please take a moment to read and check any information that pertains to you. Please understand that doing so does NOT enroll you in the WIA Dislocated Worker Program, but it does help to quickly identify possible eligibility for enrollment.

- Have you been laid off and are unlikely to return to your job and are eligible for or have exhausted unemployment?
- Are you in receipt of a notice of lay-off and will be entitled to unemployment and are unlikely to return to your job?
- Were you self-employed and dissolved your business?
- Are you a displaced homemaker who has been providing unpaid services to your family and has been dependent on the income of another family member and is no longer supported by that income?
- Are you a citizen or lawful permanent alien?
